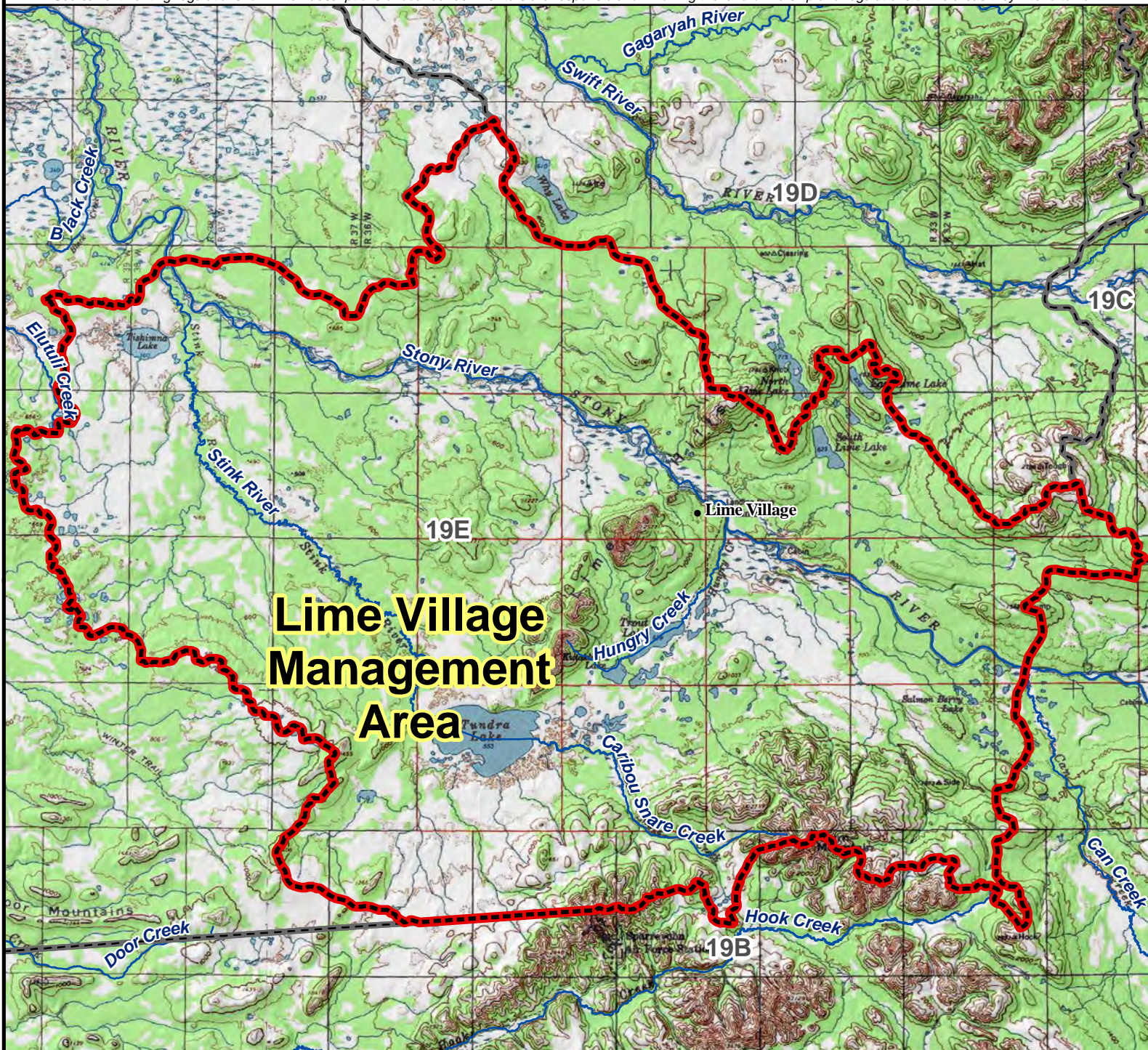


Unit 19E Lime Village Management Area

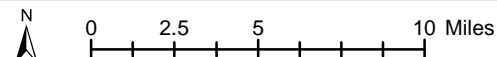

Lime Village Management Area

AREA DESCRIPTION: Unit 19E, the area consists of that portion of Unit 19E drained by the Stony River from the mouth of the Stink River, including the Stink River drainage, upstream to but not including the Can Creek drainage.

The area is open to caribou hunting as specified in 5 AAC 85.025(a) (14).
