RESOLUTION # -77 -/5-68 ALASKA BOARD OF GAME April 1977

- WHEREAS, the Board of Game has adopted a procedure for scheduling and reviewing all sections of the codified hunting and trapping regulations on a periodic basis, and;
- WHEREAS, this system has been established to provide a degree of stability for hunting and trapping activities, and;
- WHEREAS, diviations from this sytem should occur only in cases of emergency, and;
- WHEREAS, the use of the Administrative Procedure Act petition procedure
 (AS 44.62.220-230) to require the board to consider proposals in contravention of the system of periodic review of all regulations will result
 in confusion and inequities to the public, and;
- WHEREAS, the board recognizes the right of the public to petition the board as provided by law and accordingly must establish an equitable procedure for handling regulatory petitions;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Board of Game, as provided in AS 16.05.270, hereby delegates its authority to the commissioner to resolve such petitions when they pertain to sections of the codified regulations not scheduled for consideration at the next board meeting.
