**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using a backpack electrofisher and GPS. We captured juvenile coho salmon, Dolly Varden, and cutthroat trout. Pictures of juvenile coho salmon were not obtained; however, fish identification was verified by a Habitat Biologist. The tributary stream flows over a 3-to-4 ft tall falls and through a gravel-dominated channel (Table 1; Figures 1, 2).

**Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 3).
