**Findings:** We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and a GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon and cutthroat trout (Figure 1). The stream channel runs through a muskeg and into a ditch, channel continues upstream into the forest (Table 1; Figures 2, 3). **Recommendations:** Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing
