Findings: We surveyed this uncataloged stream using baited minnow traps and a GPS and captured juvenile coho salmon and cutthroat trout (Figure 1). The stream channel runs through a muskeg and fish habitat may continue upstream of the culvert (Table 1; Figure 2).

Recommendations: Add this uncataloged stream to the anadromous waters catalog for rearing coho salmon (Figure 3).
