EXPLANATION:

This emergency order supersedes Emergency Order No. 3-CS-U-18-24 issued August 14, 2024 and closes all waters of the Tanana River drainage to sport fishing for chum and coho salmon.

All chum and coho salmon caught incidentally in the Tanana River drainage while fishing for other species may not be removed from the water and must be released immediately.

REGULATION:

The provisions of 5 AAC 74.010(b)(2) are superseded by this emergency order. Under this emergency order, the following provisions are effective 12:01 a.m. Thursday, August 22 through 11:59 p.m. Tuesday, December 31, 2024:

5 AAC 74.010. Seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means for the Tanana River Area.

(b)(2) salmon, other than king salmon: the bag and possession limit is three fish, with no size limit; sport fishing for chum and coho salmon is closed; chum or coho salmon may not be retained or possessed; chum or coho salmon must be released immediately; a person may not remove a chum or coho salmon from the water before releasing the fish;

JUSTIFICATION:

Estimated passage of coho salmon past the Pilot Station sonar through August 19, 2024 was 10,935, which is well below the median cumulative count of 47,651, and is one of the lowest counts on record to date. Therefore, closure of the coho salmon sport fishery is warranted throughout the Tanana River drainage, to protect spawning escapement.

Fall chum salmon passage estimate to date at the Pilot Station Sonar (155,911) is substantially below historic averages for this time of year. The lower end of the escapement goal is 300,000 fall chum salmon and a harvestable surplus is unlikely. This emergency order continues the sport fishery closure for chum salmon.

PREVIOUS EMERGENCY ORDERS AFFECTED: Emergency Order 3-CS-U-18-24 closed sport fishing for chum salmon in the Tanana River drainage from August 16 through December 31 and is superseded by this emergency order.

Emergency Order 3-KS-U-4-24 issued on March 26, 2024 closed sport fishing for king salmon in all flowing waters of the Tanana River drainage from March 28 through September 30. In addition, the use of bait is prohibited in all Tanana River tributaries. This emergency order remains in effect.
