
## **Bristol Bay Sockeye Salmon Fishery**

## Port Moller Sockeye Salmon Stock Composition Summary June 30–July 7, 2011 – By Stations (2/4 and 6/8/10)

Genetic stock composition estimates by stations (2/4 and 6/8/10) for sockeye salmon from the Port Moller Test Fishery for June 30–July 7, 2011. A total of 545 and 416 fish were sampled and 444 and 312 fish were analyzed from stations 2/4 and 6/8/10, respectively (439 and 303 had adequate data to include in the analysis).
