

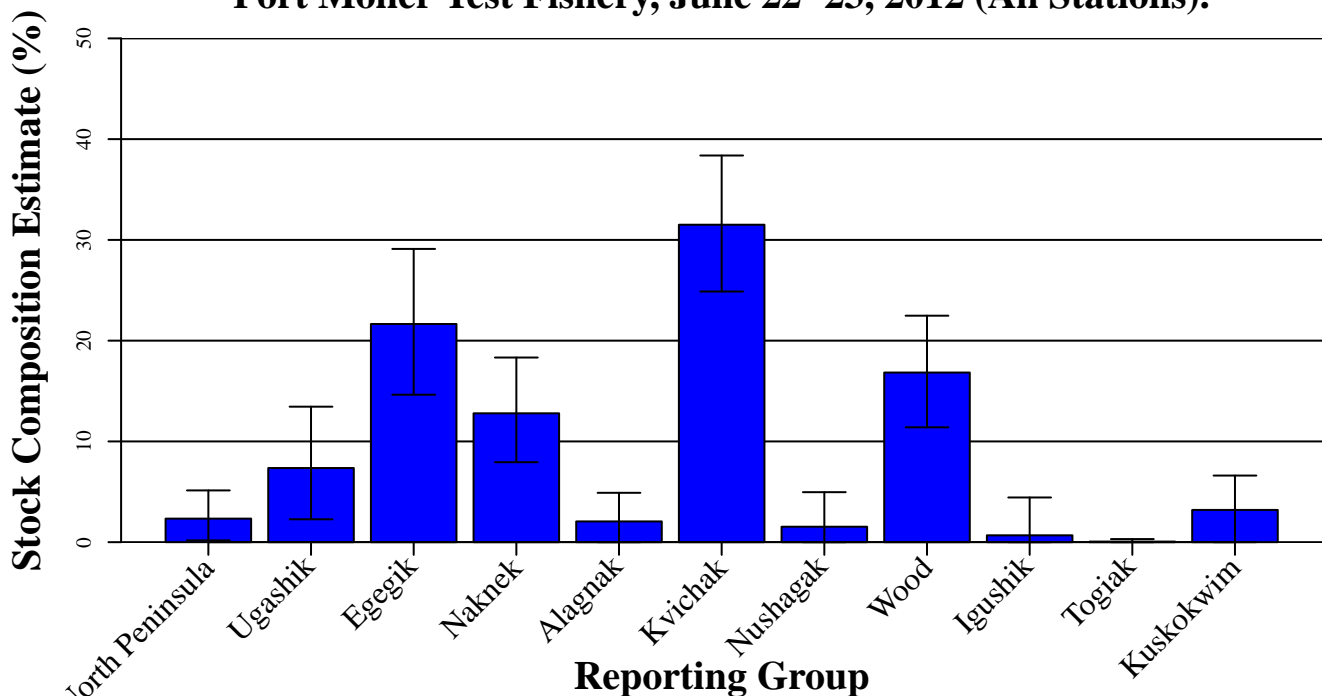
Bristol Bay Sockeye Salmon Fishery

Port Moller Sockeye Salmon Stock Composition Summary June 22–23, 2012 – All Stations

Genetic stock composition estimates for sockeye salmon from the Port Moller Test Fishery for June 22–23, 2012. A total of 569 fish were sampled and 190 were analyzed (190 had adequate data to include in the analysis).

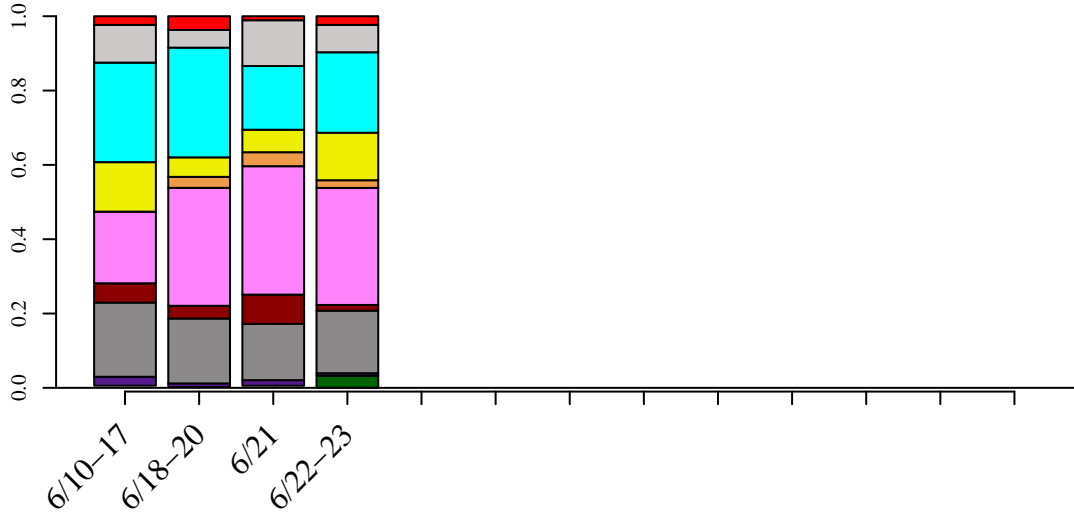
Genetic Stock Composition Estimates for Sockeye Salmon Captured in the Port Moller Test Fishery, June 22–23, 2012 (All Stations).



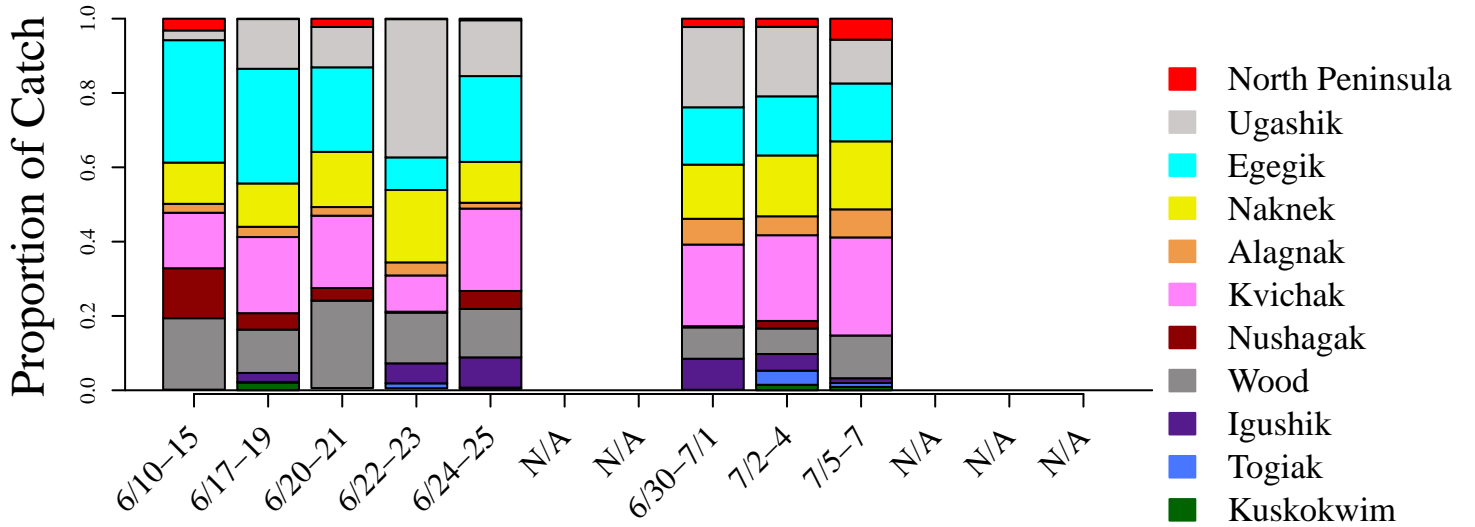

Historical Comparison of Stock Composition Estimates

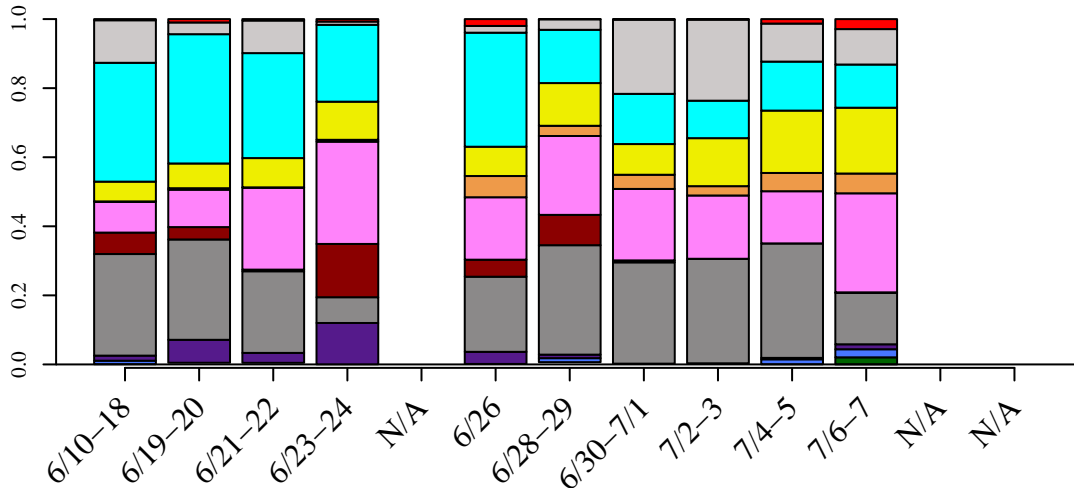

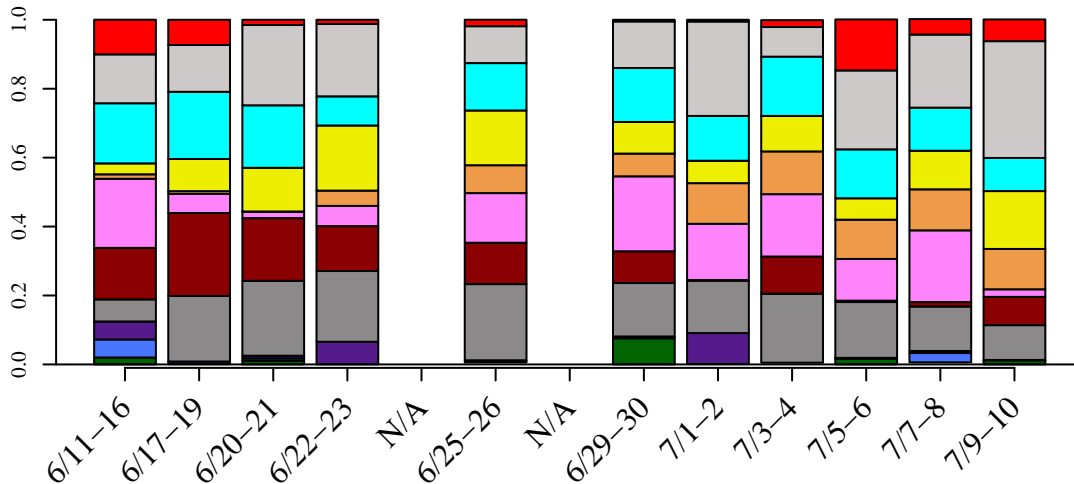
