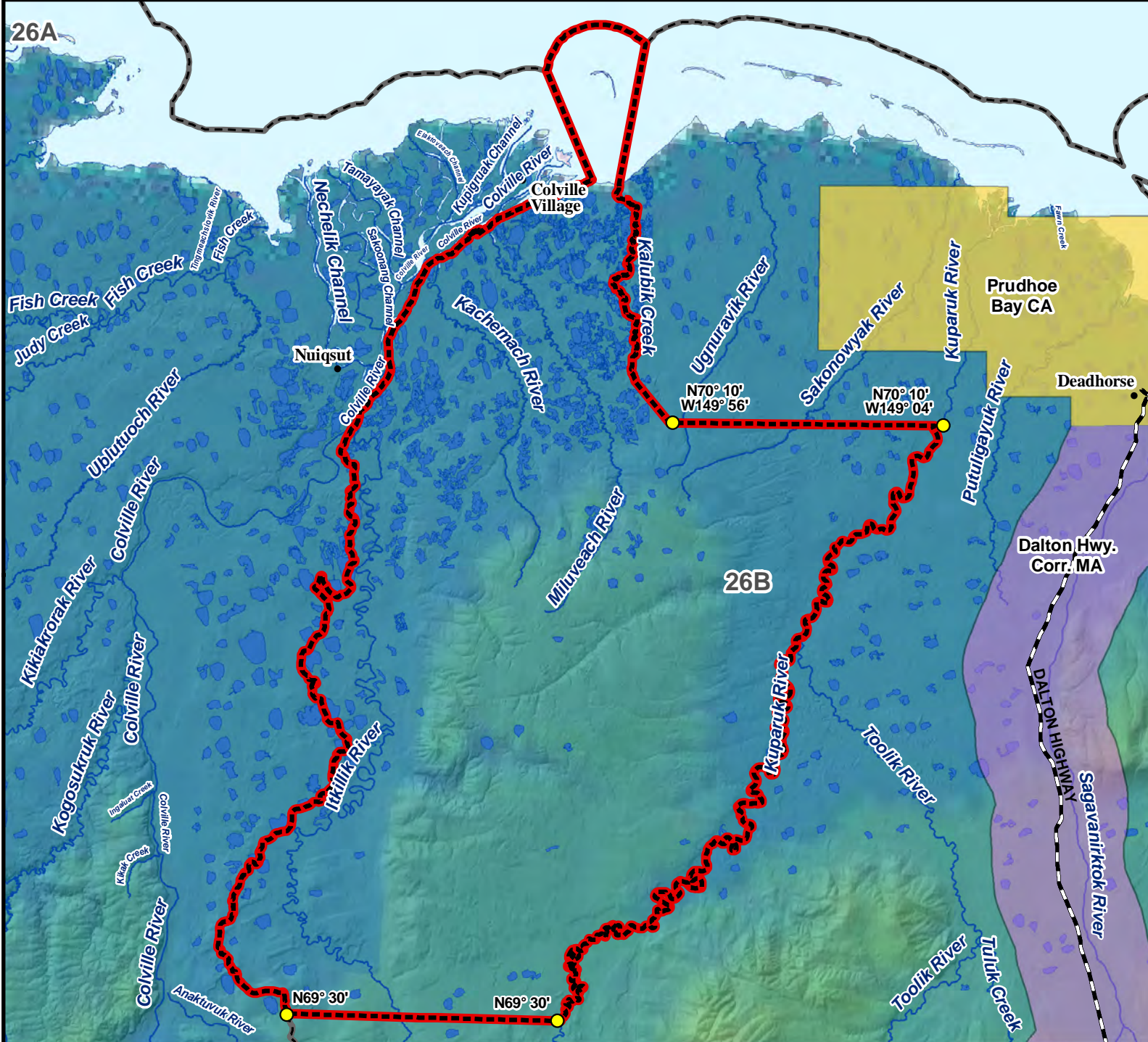


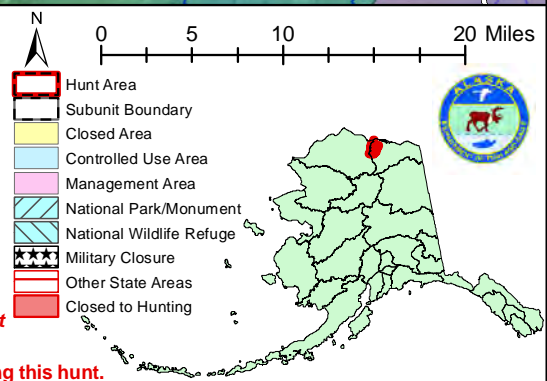
Unit 26B, Northwest Caribou - General Hunt

Residents* and Nonresidents - Harvest Ticket Required

This map is intended for hunt planning use, not for determining legal property or regulatory boundaries. Content is compiled from various sources and is subject to change without notice. See current hunting regulations for written descriptions of boundaries. Hunters are responsible for knowing the land ownership and regulations of the areas they intend to hunt.



AREA DESCRIPTION: Unit 26B, north of N69° 30' and west of the east bank of the Kuparuk River to a point at N70° 10', W149° 04', then west approximately 22 miles to N70° 10', W149° 56', then following the east bank of the Kalubik River to the Arctic Ocean.



*Residents: If you live north of the Yukon River and hunt caribou in Unit 23 or 26A, you do not need caribou harvest tickets/reports, but you must register with ADF&G or an authorized representative within the area.
