Respectfully, this finding does not address the way in which I approach hunting in general with respect to access to the field. I am an adventure seeker; I never go hunting the same place twice. Alaska is too big and beautiful to waste a season with that. I am a globe-spinner and map-flipper all winter, identify general areas of interest with respect to sheep habitat and most importantly, an area I have not visited before. Therefore when I head out in the plane, I have only a general idea of planned location. I must look for landing sites, other tents etc when I get to that larger general area, and adjust from there. Therefore, because I am not going directly to an “established or proposed campsite, pickup location, or certainly not to a specific harvest location” because in advance I do not know specifically where that will be.

This is the adventure for me, both as a sheep hunter and pilot.

Please consider revising, or adding new language to incorporate this factor.
